Growing pains in the early church.

Acts 6:1-2 In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Grecian Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food.

The solution.

Acts 6:3-5 So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be <u>full of the Spirit</u> and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word." They chose Stephen, a man <u>full of faith and of the Holy Spirit</u>; (+6)

The laying on of hands.

Acts 6:6 They presented these men to the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on them.

We could debate of the above ministries are most important.

<u>But we would agree that both are important.</u>

<u>G-2.0104</u> "Ruling elders and teaching elders, together with the deacons, exercise the ministry of the church. Although the functions of ruling elders and teaching elders differ, both are called to serve Christ and the church and <u>are equal in dignity and</u> in the sight of God."

<u>1 Corinthians 12:4-7</u> There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in all men. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.
